# COVID-19 Isolation & Quarantine Information for Parents

#### What do you need to know?!

- If your child tested Positive
- If your child is a Household Close Contact
- If your child is a Close Contact at School

### **Tested Positive with LAUSD (PCR)**

- Isolate for 10 days. Return to school on Day 11.
  - No test needed
  - Improved and/or no more symptoms

OR

- Isolate for 5 days (Shorten Isolation)
  - Take an antigen rapid test on/after day 5
    - Negative and No symptoms: return day 6
    - MUST upload the negative result on Daily Pass in order to cleared by the CE team.

### **Tested Positive (Antigen Rapid Test)**

- Upload the positive Antigen Rapid Test to Daily Pass
- Take your child to get a PCR test ASAP


District is no longer accepting Positive Antigen Rapid Test. So it's important that you take your child to get a PCR test.

If you choose to test with an non-LAUSD clinic, you will need to upload the test result.

## **Upload Antigen Rapid Test**

NEED to include information in order for the CE team to approves it!

- Student Name
- DOB
- Date of the test



#### **Household Close Contact (unable to isolate)**

Positive individual have the negative antigen test (on/after day 5)




The Day Positive individual can return to school = Day 1
Quarantine for Close contact



Close contact can test on/after day 5



Eligible to return with negative PCR test on/after day 6



## **Exempted from Quarantine**

Household Close Contact	Close Contact at school
<ul> <li>Fully Vaccinated AND Asymptomatic</li> <li>Recently recovered from COVID-19</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Asymptomatic</li> </ul>

#### Test to return to school

Positive Cases	Close Contact
Antigen Rapid Test	PCR

District will only provide antigen rapid test to students / employees who recently tested positive, and need the test to return to school/work. All close contacts and/or symptomatic individuals will need to take the PCR test.
