Morning Drop Off

- Do NOT Double Park on City Terrace Drive
- Follow the Crossing Guard's Direction
- NO Jaywalking
- Bus zone -- no parking
- Loading zone -- make sure someone stays in the car
- Side gate open at 7:40 a.m. and close at **8:00 a.m.**

Morning Drop Off

Afternoon Pick Up



- Early Out on Tuesdays (1:30 p.m.)

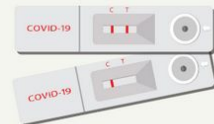
- Cell phones / Smart watches

COVID-19 Protocol

Los Angeles Unified's Updated COVID-19 Protocols



Masks: Indoor masking is strongly recommended at all schools and workplaces. Schools have surgical masks available for distribution upon request to any student or employee.



Baseline Testing: Antigen tests will be distributed to all students/staff and should be used within 48 hours prior to entering campus. Antigen at-home rapid tests will also be distributed by 8/19. Students/staff should test 48 hours before 8/22.



Weekly Testing: Los Angeles Unified is implementing a "response testing" protocol using at-home rapid antigen tests (weekly asymptomatic testing is no longer required).



Daily Pass Portal: Students will not need to generate a Daily Pass QR code in order to enter school campuses.

Indoor masking highly recommended

Baseline Rapid Test recommended. Pick up 2 kits from the office. Within 48 hours.

Response Testing – no more weekly

No more QR code

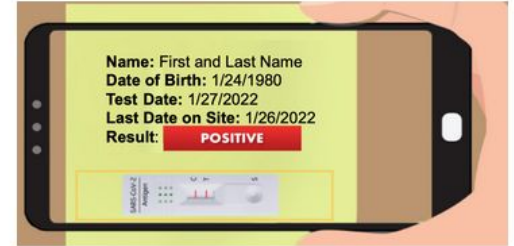
Rapid Testing – Baseline (to return on Monday, 8/15)

Students who test **NEGATIVE**:

- No further action is required
- Do not upload to Daily Pass
- Attend school

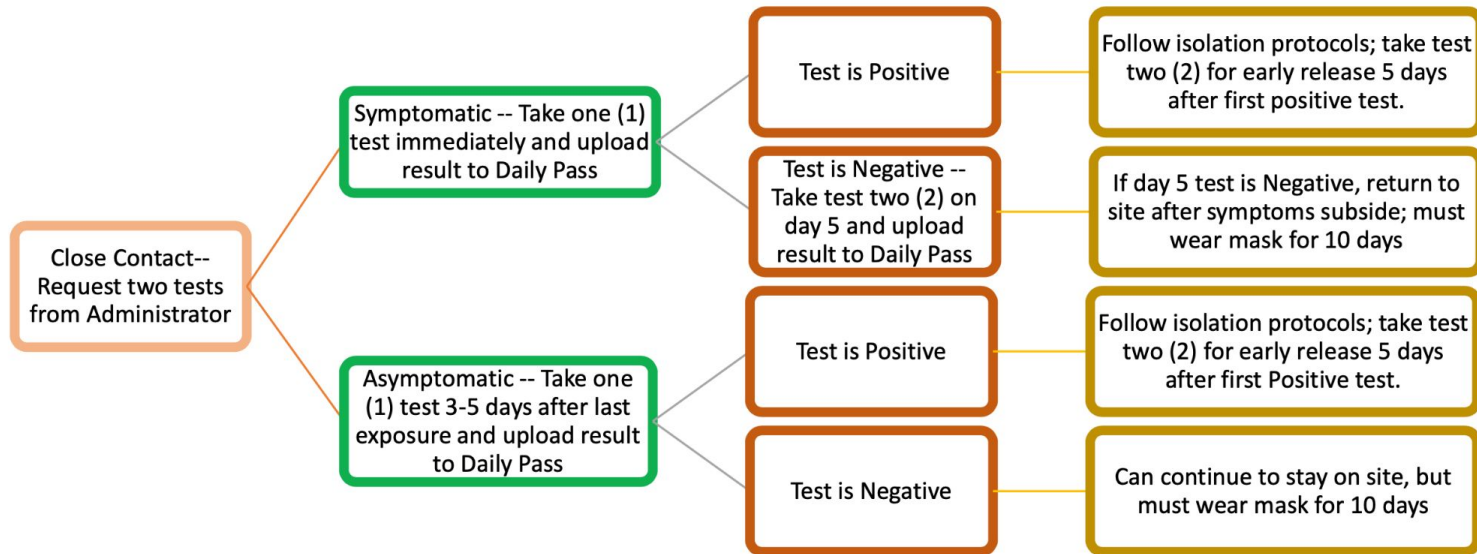
Students who test **POSITIVE**:

- Isolate immediately/ DO NOT attend school
- Contact a doctor to make a plan for care, and
- On a separate paper, write down the following information and take a picture.
 1. Full legal name,
 2. Date of birth,
 3. Test date,
 4. Last date on site, and
 5. “POSITIVE”
- Upload to dailypass.lausd.net



COVID Exposure Guidelines

Symptomatic Individuals and Close Contacts should request two (2) Rapid Antigen tests from their administrator. Response testing means only those present with symptoms, or who have been exposed to a confirmed Positive case (on or offsite), will be required to test with a Rapid Antigen test.



COVID Exposure Guidelines

Symptomatic Individuals and Close Contacts should request two (2) Rapid Antigen tests from their administrator. Response testing means only those present with symptoms, or who have been exposed to a confirmed Positive case (on or offsite), will be required to test with a Rapid Antigen test.



Symptomatic -- Request 2 tests from Administrator - Take one (1) test immediately and upload result to Daily Pass

Test is Positive -- follow isolation protocols; take test two (2) for early release on or after day 5 and upload result to Daily Pass

Test is Negative

Day 5 test is Positive

Day 5 test is Negative

Continue isolation for full 10 days

Return to site; must mask for 5 more days (10 total)

Return to site after symptoms subside

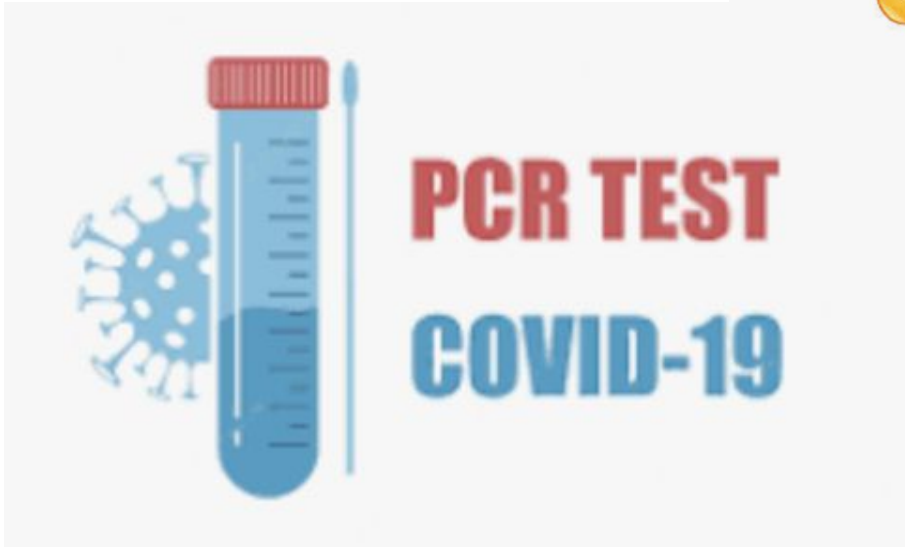
Positive: Continue isolation and return on day 11



COVID-19 PROTOCOL UPDATE (08/11/2022)

- LAUSD will provide COVID-19 Response Testing for all **staff and students**, as necessary and when the criteria require it.
- **Response testing** with rapid antigen tests is in lieu of weekly asymptomatic screening testing for everyone.
 - [ALL Rapid Test Results must be uploaded to DailyPass, regardless of test results.](#)
- Close Contacts / Symptomatic cases
 - All student and employee rapid antigen test results must be **uploaded to Daily Pass** at dailypass.lausd.net as soon as possible after the test is administered, regardless of test result.

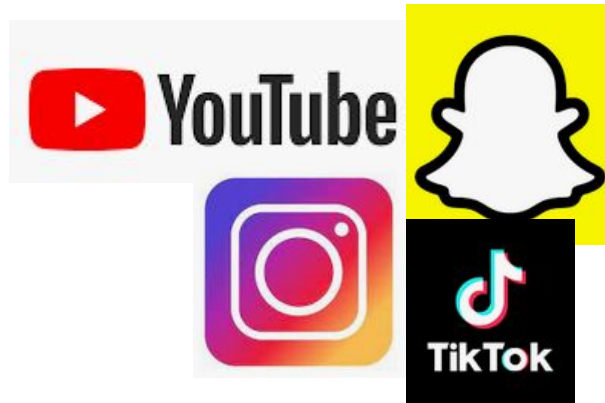

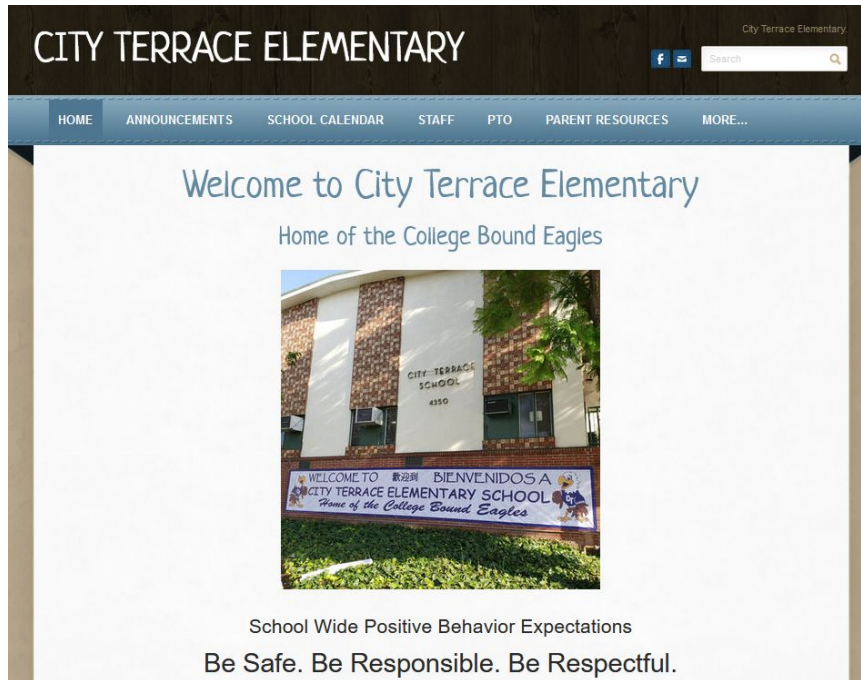
